### **Revision of SRE Policy in line with current legal requirements and the expectation that SRE will become statutory.**

The school focus is on positive interactions, developing age appropriate interpersonal skills, and to achieve these in a cross-curricular approach, involving middos training and suitable aspects of the SEAL programme. The aim is to produce emotionally literate children who will form successful interactions with family, friends and fellow pupils and which will imbue in them the skills necessary to become successful marriage partners.

The importance of hygiene and good health is a relevant aspect to be taught.

In accordance with the guidance of the Shulchan Oruch, physical aspects of relationships will be taught by parents and it is the ethos of Yesoiday HaTorah Girls' Academy to promote this. Parents who so wish will be made aware that a specific member of staff can give guidance to them in dealing with children's concerns at this time and can direct parents towards suitable resources which comply with halacha.

Parents have the right to withdraw their children from this part of the PHSE programme and alternative arrangements will be made for their children's supervision. The request to withdraw must be made in writing to the Executive Headteacher.
